

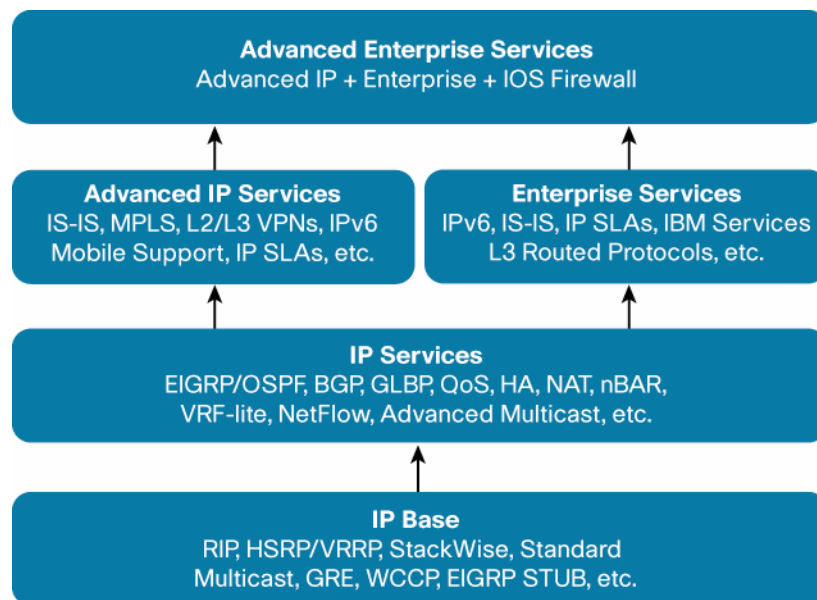
Cisco Catalyst 6500 Enterprise Services Feature Set Software Image Upgrade Promotion

Overview

Beginning with Cisco IOS® Software Release 12.2(33)SXF on the Cisco® Catalyst® 6500 Series Switches, Cisco IOS Software was offered in different reformation feature sets (see Figure 1). This allowed customers to pick and choose the appropriate feature set license based on their deployment needs. With the introduction of Cisco IOS Software Release 12.2(33)SXH, the Enterprise Services feature set was removed to consolidate the available feature sets.

Cisco IOS Software Release 12.2(33)SXH Migration

Cisco IOS Software Release 12.2(33)SXH is an Extended Maintenance release and will be supported for a period of 24 months for Cisco Catalyst 6500 Series Switches. For more details about Release 12.2SX Standard and Extended Maintenance releases, visit

Beginning with Release 12.2(33)SXH, the Enterprise Services software image was no longer offered for the Cisco Catalyst 6500 supervisor engines. This was done as part of an image/feature-set consolidation program. Existing customers running the Cisco IOS Software Enterprise Services image were entitled to receive a free license upgrade to Cisco IOS Software Advanced Enterprise Services for the Cisco Catalyst 6500 Series Supervisor Engine 720 and Cisco Catalyst 6500 Supervisor Engine 32 until January 29, 2008. Upgrade purchases beyond the January 29, 2008 date were required to pay the regular upgrade price.

Upgrade Promotion Extension

The above mentioned promotion of a free upgrade for existing customers running a Cisco IOS Software Enterprise Services image (on SXF release) to Cisco IOS Software Advanced Enterprise Services on the SXH release and beyond is being extended. The promotion will be available to only those customers that covered under a Cisco SMARTnet[®] Service contract. The promotion will expire on June 30, 2009.

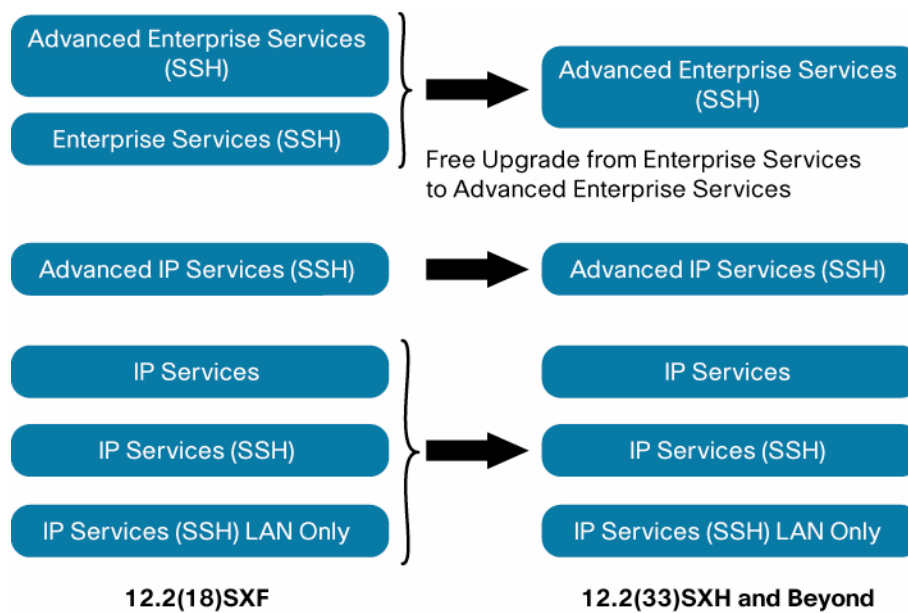

Figure 2. Supervisor-720 Software Image Upgrade to Release 12.2(33)SXH

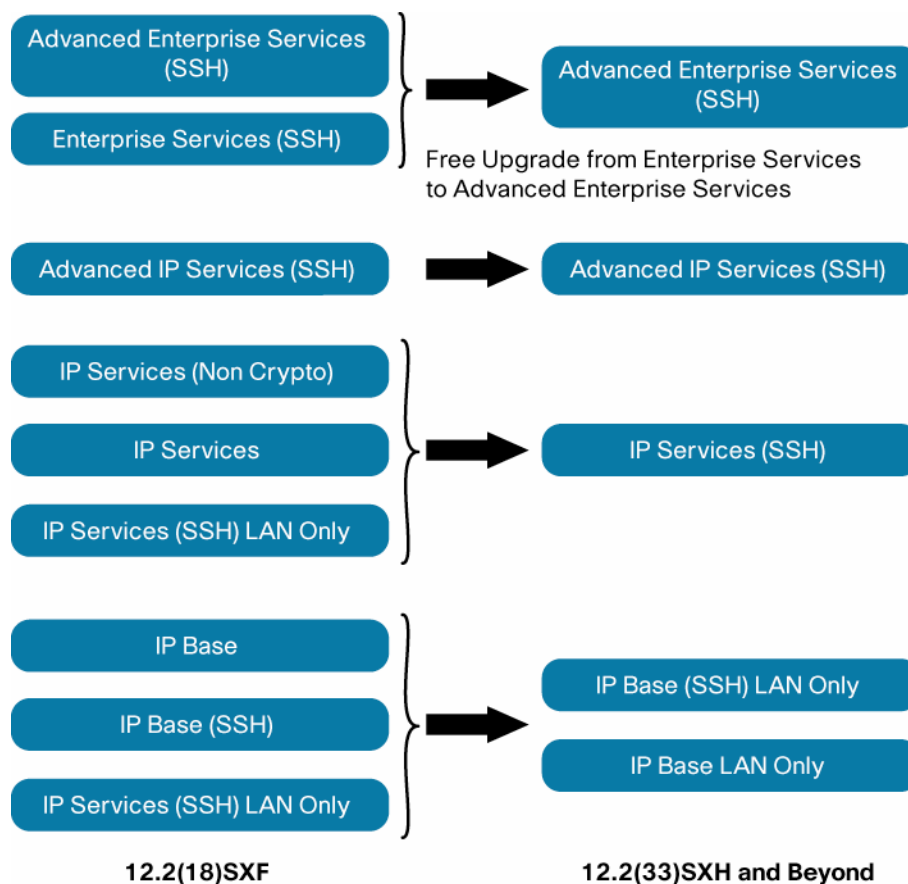
