

End-of-Sale and End-of-Life Announcement for the Cisco uBR7200 and uBR7100 Series Universal Broadband Router Components

EOL1438 - Amended

Cisco announces the end-of-sale and end-of life dates for the Cisco® uBR7200 and uBR7100 Series Universal Broadband Router Components. The last day to order the affected product(s) is November 15, 2001. Customers with active service contracts will continue to receive support from the Cisco Technical Assistance Center (TAC) as shown in Table 1 of the EoL bulletin. Table 1 describes the end-of-life milestones, definitions, and dates for the affected product(s). Table 2 lists the product part numbers affected by this announcement. For customers with active and paid service and support contracts, support will be available until the termination date of the contract, even if this date exceeds the Last Date of Support shown in Table 1.

This end of support bulletin is specific to only the uBR7200 and uBR7100 platforms. The following port adapters are no longer supported on the uBR7200 nor the uBR7100 platforms: PA-8E, PA-8T-232, PA-8T-X21, PA-4E1G/75, PA-4E1G/120, PA-MC-2T1 and PA-H. These port adapters are still available for all other supporting platforms which are the 7200, 7301, 7500 and 7600 platforms.
