



### **Getting Started with Search for Courses**

Landing on the Cisco Learning Locator Home Page




1	Location	User's current location which is derived from User's Computer IP
2	Search Courses Text Box	where user can enter preferred keywords to search
3	Filters	Additional search criteria that user can apply by expanding and selecting
4	Apply or Reset Filters	Functionality to apply the selected filter values along with keyword text entered at the time of applying the filters.

 User can perform the search either by logging in using CCO user and password OR without logging into the tool. If the user has already logged into Cisco.Com and navigates the GLL, the logged in status of the user shall continue as is. Tool does not require any explicit login.


### Course Listing Page


Search results either by entering the keywords or by applying the filters etc., results in listing of courses that match the criteria. Following is an example of Course Listing where user has entered Data Center as keyword to search for. The section highlighted is "Course Listing" page. At the top of the list, count of courses that met the search criteria is displayed.



### Course Offerings Listing Page

Upon clicking on one of the Course Titles or on the Offering Counts displayed against the Course listed on **Course Listing Page** will result in user being navigated to Course Offerings Page.





		<ul> <li>a) Course Delivery Method based tabs to list the course offerings of individual delivery method type.</li> <li>b) Viewing of Course Offerings in the listing form OR in the map form.</li> <li>c) Advanced Filters that support fine-grained search for a course offering based on the <ul> <li>Geography of the course offerings {Country, State and City]</li> <li>Language of the course offerings</li> <li>Learning Partner conducting the offerings</li> <li>Range of Date {Offering Start Date} to select from</li> </ul> </li> <li>d) Bottom section of the table shows the actual "Course Offering Listing" that meet the selection criteria of the user.</li> </ul>
4	Enroll Button	At the bottom of the page, tool displays the Page Number and total number of pages that the course offerings are listed. User can select the page to navigate to.  Each Offering listed will be accompanied with an "Enroll" button that links and navigates the user to the Learning Partner Offering page.
5	Pagination Module, Return to results Links	Return to results link is displayed both at the bottom and at the top of the page. By clicking on this link, user can navigate back to the "Course Listing Page", where the user would have navigated from.


## **Keyword based Search for Courses**

- Basic Keyword-based Search to find course(s)
- Search can be conducted based on various important terms that are used to describe a course
  - ♣ Course Acronym or Abbreviated Name
  - ♣ Course Name or Title
  - Technology
  - Certification(s)
  - Specialization(s)

Note: There are advanced search options available to the user, as the user navigates to the course offering page. Those are described in the later sections of this document.

Any or all of the above can be entered by the user to initiate the search in the text box.

✓ Let's start with the simplest example of Course Acronym or Abbreviation based Search Results Page, which is also called as "Course Listing Page":



1	Search Courses	Text Box allows user to enter the keyword for search. While entering, tool does provide appropriate hints (typeahead values). User may decide to pick one amongst the displayed value(s) or enter the keyword of his/her own choice. E.g. in this case user entered keyword value of "ICND1"
2	Course Title / Acronym	Course Listing Page will list each Course Title along with the Course Acronym and Version of the course that it represents. User may decide to click on the offerings count to get to the "Course Description" section of the "Course Offering Page"
3	Leads to Certification(s)	Subject to applicability, each course listing shall include Course type and Certification that the course leads to. Courses that do not lead to any particular certification will not display "Leads to Certification(s)" information against that particular course.
4	Offerings	If a given course is being offered, total count of offerings across the globe will be displayed as a count. E.g. 6808 active offerings are being conducted for ICND1 course. User may decide to click on the offerings count to get to the "Course Offering Listing" section of the "Course Offering Page"

#### Multiple Keywords based search to find Course(s)

User may choose to enter multiple keywords E.g. in this case user wants to search for more than one Security course and has entered keyword values of "SESA1" and "PASESA" separated by comma. Tool will bring in appropriate results and will highlight the matching terms used in the keyword to search for.



### Using Left Navigation Filters (and keywords) to find Course(s)

#### **Default location / Changing or adding new locations**

Location of the user at the Country & State level is determined based on the IP of the device connected. .



1	Location	Default Location based off of user's device IP.
2	Add additional Country & State	To add additional Countries or States, click on the "funnel" icon. Popup will display text area where user can enter the name of the entry to be added to the list.
3	Expand-Collapse Country Names	Upon addition of the country to the selected list, click on expand icon to list states within the country. User may select one or more states or the entire country by selecting appropriate checkboxes.
4	Save Selection	After selecting appropriate Countries and/or States, user can "Save Selection" to the left-nav. After confirming the selection, close the pop-up window by clicking on the icon.

### **Selecting Certification, Technology and Specialization Filters**

By clicking on individual accordion categories of Certification, Technology the collapsed drawers can be opened. User can select "checkbox" against individual values displayed in each such category of choices.

After completing the selection, user may apply the filters by clicking on

Apply Filters

button.

#### **Reset Filters**

All applied filters can be reset or cleared by clicking on "Reset Filters" link at the bottom of the accordion. Reset Filters can also be used to initiate a new search.

#### **Course Offering Listing Page Filters**

Course Offering Listing Page allows the user to narrow down the choice of offerings by applying following filters,

- o Country, State, City User can select one Country and/or State and/or City at a time.
- o Language User can select one Language at a time.
- Learning Partner User can select one Learning Partner at any given time.
- Date Range User has the option to select a range of date which can be applied to select
  offerings that start between that date range.
