# Uninstall Cisco Crosswork Change Automation and Health Insights and Cisco Crosswork Data Gateway

The procedure to remove a Cisco Crosswork Change Automation and Health Insights VM and Cisco Crosswork Data Gateway VM is the same.



### Note

- Be aware that this procedure removes all your Cisco Crosswork Change Automation and Health Insights and Cisco Crosswork Data Gateway data.
- **If you want to uninstall Cisco Crosswork Data Gateway only**, ensure you have done the following:
  - Detach the devices from the Cisco Crosswork Data Gateway VM you want to uninstall. The procedure to detach devices from a Crosswork Data Gateway is described in *Cisco Crosswork Change Automation and Health Insights 3.1 User Guide*.
  - De-enroll the Cisco Crosswork Data Gateway from Cisco Crosswork Change Automation and Health Insights as described in [De-enroll Cisco Crosswork Data Gateway](#).

- Step 1** Log in to the VMware vSphere Web Client.
- Step 2** In the **Navigator** pane, right-click the Cisco Crosswork Change Automation and Health Insights VM or Cisco Crosswork Data Gateway VM that you want to remove and choose **Power > Power Off**.
- Step 3** Once the VM is powered off, right-click the VM again and choose **Delete from Disk**.  
The VM is removed.
