Feature	Description
Configuration Archive Support	Cisco DNA Center performs an automated backup process that is scheduled to run every day at 11:00 p.m. (UTC time zone). See Configure Device Configuration Backup Settings .

Feature	Description
AP Location Configuration for PnP Onboarding	You can configure the site assigned during the PnP claim as the AP location for PnP onboarding. See Configure AP Location for PnP Onboarding .
View Cisco ISE Integration Status	You can view the Cisco ISE device integration status in the Inventory window. See Configure Authentication and Policy Servers .
View Tasks and Work Items	When you deploy a group of devices, the activity is consolidated into one main task. You can view the device-specific tasks that are a part of the main task. See View Tasks and Work Items .
Visibility and Control of Configurations	With the enhanced control component of this feature, you can send planned network configurations to IT Service Management (ITSM) for approval before deploying them. Control ensures that only authentic and authorized configurations are provisioned onto your network devices, which further secures your devices. See Enable Visibility and Control of Configurations .
