About the Cisco ACI App Center

The Cisco ACI App Center for ACI apps allows you to fully enable the capabilities of the APIC by adding applications to the controller. These applications are hosted and shared at the Cisco ACI App Center and installed in the APIC.

Using Cisco ACI App Center

As an end user, you can use the Cisco ACI App Center to browse for apps and download them.

Procedure

Step 1 Log in to [Cisco ACI App Center](#) as an end user.

Step 2 You can perform the following actions as an end user.

Action	Description
Browse apps	Click Browse Apps to list all the apps that can be downloaded.
Search for apps...	Enter the name of the app to search for a specific app.
View Details	Click Browse apps, then the list icon and locate your app. Click See More... to view app details and reviews.
Download	then See #unique_4
Downloaded Apps	Choose User Name > My Account to view the apps you have downloaded.

Downloading Application From the Cisco ACI App Center

Use this procedure to download Cisco Application Services Engine app from the Cisco ACI App Center.

Procedure

- Step 1** Log in to the [Cisco ACI App Center](#) as an end user.
- The **Introducing the Cisco App Center** banner appears. The banner scrolls to reveal other options. These options include:
- The **Application Centric Infrastructure (ACI)** banner: Click **Explore Now** to view videos and other content about ACI.
 - The **Cisco DevNet** banner: Click **Join Now** to access the **Cisco DevNet** portal.
 - **Network for developers** banner: Click **Sign Up**, then **Developers** to access the **Cisco DevNet** portal.
- Step 2** On the **Introducing the Cisco App Center** banner, click **Browse apps** to view the available apps.
- The apps available for download are displayed in the **All** window. You can perform the following to locate and learn about each app:
- Click the **Minimum Requirements** drop down list to choose the APIC version number you are using. The apps supported by the APIC version are displayed.
 - Click the list icon to display the available apps in the list view. You can click **See More...** to view additional information about the app or click **Download** to begin the process of downloading the app to your local machine.
- Step 3** Locate the app you want to use and click **Download**.
- Step 4** Review the license agreement and click **Agree and download**.
- The app is downloaded to your local machine.

Upgrading Application From the Cisco ACI App Center

If you upgraded from a release prior to the Cisco APIC 3.2(1) release and you had any apps installed prior to the upgrade, the apps will no longer work. To use the apps again, you must uninstall and reinstall them.
