About Ansible

Ansible is an open-source IT automation engine that automates cloud provisioning, configuration management, application deployment, intra-service orchestration, and other IT needs.

Ansible uses small programs called Ansible modules to make API calls to your nodes, and apply configurations defined in playbooks.

By default, Ansible represents what machines it manages using a very simple INI file that puts all of your managed machines in groups of your own choosing.
