Access Cisco Unified CM IM and Presence Administration

Complete the following procedure to access the Cisco Unified CM IM and Presence Administration interface.

Procedure

Step 1	Open a browser and enter https:// <server address="" ip="" name="" or="">, where the server name or IP address equals the server where the IM and Presence Service is installed.</server>
Step 2	From Administrative Applications, select Cisco Unified Communications Manager IM and Presence.
Step 3	If the system prompts you about certificates, you must enable HTTPS to secure communications between the browser client and the web server. See the <i>Release Notes for Cisco Unified Communications Manager</i> for more information about how to load the required certificates for the HTTPS connection.
Step 4	Enter the application username and application user password that you specified during installation when the system prompts you for a user name and password. The Cisco Unified CM IM and Presence Administration interface displays.
Step 5	To access other IM and Presence interfaces, select an interface from the Navigation drop-down list and select Go .

Procedure

Step 1	Open a browser and enter https:// <server address="" ip="" name="" or="">, where the server name or IP</server>
	address equals the server where Cisco Unified Communications Manager is installed.
Step 2	From the list of Installed Applications, select Cisco Unified Communications Manager.

- **Step 3** If the system prompts you about certificates, you must enable HTTPS to secure communications between the browser client and the web server.
- **Step 4** Enter the application username and application user password that you specified during installation and log in to the interface.
- **Step 5** To access other Cisco Unified Communications Manager interfaces, select an interface from the Navigation drop-down list and click **Go**.
